

**TOWN OF ESTO, FLORIDA
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

The Town of Esto plans to apply to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for a FFY 2020 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) of \$600,000. The activities, dollar amount and estimated percentage benefit to low- and moderate-income persons are as follows:

The proposed grant funded project will benefit the entire Town of Esto as controlling storm water will improve the quality of life throughout the Town. The proposed improvements include:3,800 feet of street improvements; drainage culverts replaced and enlarged; concrete spillways added; appropriate ditches installed adjacent to roadway to carry all stormwater to retention pond located at John Clark Park, 1009 Commerce Street.

The Town of Esto does not expect that anyone will be displaced because of CDBG-funded activities. If any persons are displaced because of the planned activities, the Town of Esto will assist them as described in the Town's anti-displacement and relocation policy, which is available for review at Town Hall.

A public hearing to provide citizens an opportunity to comment on the application will be held at Esto Town Hall, 3312 2nd Avenue S, on Thursday, November 12, 2020 at 6:00 pm. A draft copy of the application will be available for review in the Clerk's Office at Town Hall by noon on Wednesday, November 11, 2020. A final copy of the application will be made available for review during normal business hours of 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the Clerk's Office at Town Hall no later than 7:00am on November 27, 2020. The application will be submitted to DEO on or before November 30, 2020.
