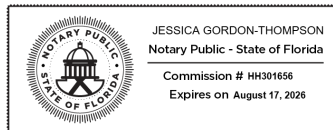

A Public Hearing
on Ordinance 2025-04
was held by the Town
Council Tuesday, April
15, 2025, and a Second
and Final Hearing will
be held Tuesday, May
20, 2025, at 7:00 p.m.,
or as soon thereafter
as possible, at Esto
Town Hall, 3312 2nd
Ave South, Esto, Flori-
da. The Town Council
may continue or defer
the hearing to a new
date and time certain
without further notice
provided the date and
time of the contin-
uance or deferral is
announced at the hear-
ing. The Ordinance
in its entirety may be
inspected at the Office
of the Town Clerk
during regular working
hours.

Pursuant to Florida
Statutes 286.0105, if
a person decides to
appeal any decision
made by the Town
Council with respect to
any matter consid-
ered at such meeting
or hearing, he or she
will need a record of
the proceedings, and
for such purpose, he
or she may need to
ensure that a verbatim
record of the proceed-
ings is made, which
record includes tes-
timony and evidence
upon which the appeal
is to be based.

Any and all interest-
ed parties may appear
at the above meeting
and be heard with re-
spect to the proposed
items.
