NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town Council of the Town of Esto proposes to adopt OR-DINANCE 2025-04:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ESTO, FLORIDA AMENDING ORDINANCES 00-01 AND 07-17 BUSINESS TAX RECEIPTS TO CLARIFY AND UP-DATE PROVISIONS; COMPLY WITH STATE STATUTES PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A Public Hearing on Ordinance 2025-04 was held by the Town Council Tuesday, April 15, 2025, and a Second and Final Hearing will be held Tuesday, May 20, 2025, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, at Esto Town Hall, 3312 2nd Ave South, Esto, Florida. The Town Council may continue or defer the hearing to a new date and time of the continuance or deferral is announced at the hearing. The Ordinance in its entirety may be inspected at the Office of the Town Clerk during regular working hours.

Pursuant to Florida Statutes 286.0105, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Town Council with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

Any and all interested parties may appear at the above meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed items.
